1 Beaded Frame

The perforated beaded edge allows plastering right up to the door edge. Creates the concealed frame effect.

Double Wide Beaded Frame Option

As above but allows for fixings to reach studwork set further back from the aperture in some wall constructions.

2 Picture Frame

Ideal for finished walls, the 25mm flange is a clean finish to cover the edge of the aperture.

3 Dutch Fold/Safety Edge

Delete the traditional flange for a 2.4mm edge detail.

No Bottom Flange Option

Delete the threshold flange so the door can sit onto the floor or skirting board. The other 3 sides can be beaded of picture frame types.

4 8mm Raised Picture Frame

For pre-plastered walls, a raised Picture Frame flange, either for decorative purposes which also provides extra rigidity to wider Picture Frame finishes.
